## other ideas

- I like my accessories loud and sassy. If you want something more subdued, simply tone down your design and color scheme.
- Paint a design that continues all the way around the body of the hat.
- To make uniform dots, use a pencil eraser as a stamp.
- If you don't feel like painting, cut out illustrations or shapes from fabric and glue them onto the hat.
- Instead of painting the ribbon to use as trim, use patterned trim, yarns, fibers, or cording as a hat band.
- Keep in mind that the idea is to create different textures. Glitter on paint, glitter on fabric, paint on glitter.
